Cressage, Harley and Sheinton Parish Council

The Parish Council does not meet in August, so the next meeting of the Parish Council will be held on Tuesday 9th September at 7pm, at Cressage Village

There is always a public forum in the Parish Council meetings for residents to raise issues of concern. At the meeting held on July 8th, this included mention of overhanging hedges impeding footpaths. Homeowners are reminded that this is their responsibility.

The project to install a village gateway at both entrances to Cressage on the A458 has now been completed. A maintenance plan for keeping the area tidy and clear will be discussed at the Parish Council meeting on 9th September. Comments from residents requesting that the 30mph speed limit in the village is extended have been noted. Shropshire Council is the Highways Authority, so this is within their remit.

A quote has been accepted to move the defibrillator located at Cressage Village Hall. This follows a recent incident where a car was parked in front of it impeding access to it when it was needed by a local resident. It will be moved to the front of the Village Hall so it is more visible from the road and is more accessible for anyone who may need to use it.

A new planning application has been put forward for the Eagles Inn. This will be to change the building from a pub into two residential dwellings. The Parish Council has agreed to file a comment in support. Councillors would like to see the site developed. Details of the new plans can be found on Shropshire Council's website:
